RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entries will be accepted in the Educational Building between 9:00a.m. and 3:00p.m. on Saturday, September 10, 2011.
2. Entries must remain in place until Sunday, September 18. They must be picked up on between 2:00-4:00p.m.

General Rules for Entries:

1. Artwork must not be over two years old and never entered in this show before.
2. The exhibitor must be a resident of Ouachita Co.
3. All work must be the original work of the artist. If a copy is entered, it will be left to the judge's discretion to be judged or not.
4. There is a limit of one picture in each class.
5. District Fair will only accept framed photos.
6. State Fair requires no smaller than 8 x 10 and no larger than 11 x 14. No frames accepted.
7. The committee reserves the right to reject any work it considers unsuitable for exhibition.

ADULT ART

ELIGIBILITY:

The show is open to all professional and non-professional artists 18 years and over. A Professional artist is anyone that advertises or commissions paintings. A limit of one picture in each category. No entry fee to exhibit.

YOUTH ART

1. The work will be hung by age groups:

A. pre-school - K

C. Grades 5-8

B. grades 1- 4

D. grades 9-12

2. All framed with glass work must have a wire hanger. Work that is matted or un-matted will be hung on a clothes line or kept in place with nails or tacks. Tape turns loose in the heat and falls for people to walk upon.

AWARDS and JUDGING

Cash awards and ribbons 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons will be given in youth art, professional, and non-professional divisions. The judges may award honorable mention ribbons at their discretion. There will be a Best of Show in youth art, in professional and in non-professional divisions.

Work will not be judged against other work except for the Best of Show. Rather, each work will be judged on its own merit by the judges' opinion.
