## Junior & Open

1. Exhibitors must comply with general and department rules and regulations.
2. An exhibitor is limited to one (1) entry in each class.
3. Enter potted plants on **Saturday, September 10 from 9:00a.m until 3:00 p.m.**
4. Enter Floriculture specimens on Monday, September 12 from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m.
5. All exhibits must be grown in containers by the exhibitor and in the exhibitor's possession at least three months before the Fair.
6. Bottles will be furnished.
7. No state conservation materials or wild flowers permitted.
8. Plants should not be decorated or polished.
9. Oversize plants must be handled by exhibitor.
10. Plants in containers should be clean and looking their best.
11. Exhibitors are responsible for watering plants.
