Junior and Open

1. An exhibitor is limited to one entry in each class.
2. All exhibits must be prepared by the exhibitor.
3. All jars must be labeled, please put a label of product on the side of the jar.
4. Standard canning jars & lids must be used. Jars must be sealed, paraffin seals will not be allowed.
5. If two-piece lids are used, rings must be on. Lids and rings should be clean and free of rust.
6. Food Coloring will not be accepted.
7. Food Preservation must follow Cooperative Extension Service recommendations.
