

DEPARTMENT-HAY SHOW

1. Hay must be produced in Ouachita County in 2010. One entry per class per person.
3. Entry must be at least two blocks or the equivalent in weight when using round bales.
4. Hay must be labeled with the name variety as listed in the classification, owner and address and how used on the farm.
5. Purity of variety will be a factor in judging.

SECTION 9501 - A. Forage tested hay.

DIVISION - OPEN 95012

Points allowed: 10 - 8 - 6

1. Hay samples for forage tests must be submitted for the laboratory analysis by Friday, July 29, 2011.
2. Forage tests may be obtained by calling the Ouachita County Extension Office, by July 24 or private laboratory. The owner will pay for the forage tests.

SECTION 9502 - B. Non-tested hay.

DIVISION - OPEN 95022

Points allowed: 5 - 4 - 3

1. Hay will be judged mainly on quality, purity, and eye appeal.
2. Hay must be easily identifiable with classifications.
