WESTERN DIVISION
HORSE SHOW
Open Class Only

1. NO STALLIONS ALLOWED

2. Only the horse will be judged, not the exhibitor.
3. Health papers will be checked.
4. Two entries per class per person.
5. All horses must be ready for judging one-half hour prior to their class.
6. Horses must be brought to show ring promptly at the call of the judge.
7. This show is a county enterprise, not conducted for profit.
8. Classes where there is no competition, the judge will make the award he/she thinks the entry merits.
9. The decision of the judge will be final in all classes.
10. All exhibitors must agree that the management will not be held responsible for accident, injury, illness or loss of animal or property during show and en-route to the fair.
11. Any sick, unsound or any animal determined by the superintendent to be unfit will not be allowed to enter and must be removed from the fairgrounds.
12. The livestock superintendent will assign pens or stalls.
13. Each exhibitor will be given a show number. This number must be worn above the left pocket of shirt.
14. No one other than the exhibitor, animal and the judge are allowed in the show ring.
15. Under 55 inch class will be measured.
16. No decoration will be allowed on the animal.

Exhibitors Attire

In all Western Classes it is mandatory to wear appropriate western attire including long sleeves and blue jeans or western style jeans. No sweat shirts, T-shirts or pull overs allowed. Western boots must be worn, no sneakers type sport shoes. Ball caps are not acceptable, western hats black or straw only. The dress code will be followed by all participants.

Tack and Equipment

All classes will be shown with halter with lead rope attached. Silver tack is okay but remember only the horse is being judged.

Holding Area

Horses for competition will be kept in stalls at the fair grounds. Each horse owner is responsible for providing feed and bedding for his or her horse while at the show. Holding area must be kept neat and clean and litter free.

Horse Health

Horses for the show must be healthy and sound. A negative Equine Infections Anemia (Coggins) test conducted within 12 months of the show date is required. No Exceptions. Coggins will be checked by certified EIA inspector.

Nursing foals under 6 months of age are exempt from testing if accompanied by negative tested dam. Photocopies of the test papers will not be accepted. Carbon copies are acceptable.
